- Have completed university studies (or equivalent) in journalism, media and/or communication studies, or a similar focus.
- Can communicate fluently in written and spoken English and a second EU language. A
 good command of spoken and written German is an asset.
- Have an interest on the topic of domestic violence perpetrator work and previous work experience on gender-based violence. Knowledge of gender equality issues and LGBTQ+ rights are an asset.
- Possess strategic and conceptual skills coupled with the ability to implement projects pragmatically.
- Are proficient in social media management and digital communications. Knowledge of Typo3 & WordPress CMS, Adobe Creative Suite and Canva is an asset.
- Are creative and can think on your feet.
- Can work independently but are still great at teamwork.
- Are willing to take responsibility and enjoy challenges.
