

## Freelance Contract

### WWP EN Outcome Monitoring Toolkit Researcher

#### 1. Project Description

##### Summary

The European Network umbrella organisation for the work with perpetrators of domestic violence is seeking a qualified, self-sufficient, and thorough researcher to undertake a freelance contract.

Using existing questionnaires, you will update and maintain online data collection systems, develop templates to examine data over time, analyse the gathered data, present findings in reports for users of the system and contribute to the development of the project.

The contract price is 9,500 euros and initially runs from June 2018 to 31.12.18, with the possibility of further contracts being awarded. The contractor must live in a European Union country.

##### Main Duties and Responsibilities

1. Finalise set up and update of questionnaires on the WWP EN website using "LimeSurvey".
2. Set up and run systems to collect data from user organisations.
3. "Clean" data for use.
4. Create several templates (from simple to complex).
5. Write reports for users, using above templates.
6. Help the Research and Development Manager to develop the project

## 2. Person Specification and Requirements

### Education/Qualifications

1. Masters or PhD degree in research or related field – should include experience of using statistical methods/statistical skills.

### Knowledge and Experience

1. Proven experience in the field of research.
2. Knowledgeable in various research methodologies, including data analysis on group comparison, differences between groups and ability to analyse data gathered over time.
3. Experience in harmonisation of data.
4. Knowledge of (or ability to pick up quickly) the use and update of online research databases questionnaire tool, i.e. Lime Survey software.
5. Experience in “cleaning” data.
6. Experience using statistical analysis software.
7. Understanding of issues around gender-based violence, particularly domestic violence/intimate partner violence.
8. Knowledge of the voluntary/NGO sector.
9. Understanding of and adherence to strict confidentiality and data protection clauses.

### Skills and Abilities

1. Ability to create a variety of report templates and write subsequent reports from the data, from simple to complex ones.
2. Ability to match the work to the needs of practitioners.
3. Excellent report writing skills, particularly an ability to present academic data in a way that non-academics can easily understand and to present analysis including descriptives.
4. Be self-directed, i.e. have the ability to prioritise workload, work to deadlines and manage own time.
5. Be highly detailed oriented and very well organized with the ability to communicate well in writing and verbally.
6. Can communicate fluently in English, with a helpful and friendly manner.
