Project "Rising the awareness of Estonian specialists about domestic violence" (01.09.2021-28.02.2023)

- Aim is to reduce violence and gender-based violence among Estonian society and to raise the awareness of specialists working in the field.
- As a result of the project there was created an analysis about the need of training of the specialist and 2 training programs according to the needs (6 hours long and 36 hours long programs).
- There will be 12 trainings all over Estonia web based and contact ones
- Project partner is MARTA Center from Latvia
