ANNUAL WORKSHOP - POLAND - CRACOW 2016

The Annual Workshop will be held in the beautiful city of Cracow in Poland from 12 till 14th October.

It will be an occasion to get to know each other better, exchange work experiences and benefit from new ideas and networking. The meeting is planned for 60-100 participants.

The key focus for this year's meeting is: "Quality Standards in Work with Perpetrators" in the context of the Guidelines for Developing Standards of Work with Perpetrators drawn up by WWP in 2008. We hope that cooperative dialogue and reflection on this topic could bring refreshing perspective to develop and update standards.

We propose the Meeting to be interactive as much as possible to make space for conversations, discussing contrasting opinions and views on what works effectively with male perpetrators of domestic violence for protection and safety of victims. We plan panel discussions, questions and answers sessions, workshops, presentations and team work sessions to spread best practices, proven solutions and knowledge that improves our work. What we need for sure are examples of successes in this challenging and complex field that can be redone in different parts of Europe.

For sure, wide international collaboration could enrich the regional approaches to achieve change in men's abusive behaviour.
